

Supreme Court mulls 24X7 emergency protocol for life, liberty

The Supreme Court agreed to consider framing a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for immediate judicial access in urgent cases affecting life and liberty.

A proposed protocol by the Supreme Court to allow citizens to approach courts 24/7 for urgent cases involving fundamental rights like life and liberty.

Article 32 grants citizens the **Right to Constitutional Remedies** to move the Supreme Court for the enforcement of **fundamental rights**.

The Supreme Court can issue **writs** like **Habeas Corpus**, Mandamus, Prohibition, Certiorari, and Quo Warranto under **Article 32**.

Habeas Corpus writ is used to produce a person who has been **illegally detained** before a court.

Public Interest Litigation (PIL) allows any public-spirited individual or organization to **seek justice** on behalf of those who cannot approach the court.

The concept of **Judicial Activism** refers to the judiciary's proactive role in **protecting and promoting the rights** of citizens and upholding the Constitution.
