

TN Government Releases White Papers on State Finances

The Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam (TVK) government, which assumed office on May 10, 2026, has published two White Papers on public finances and power utilities.

White Papers are official government reports providing detailed information and analysis on specific policy areas, often used to inform public debate and policy decisions.

The **Tamil Nadu State Budget** is presented annually by the **Finance Minister** in the **Legislative Assembly**, outlining the state's estimated revenues and expenditures.

The **Kalaigarn Mahalir Urimai Thittam**, launched by the Tamil Nadu government, provides a monthly financial assistance of **₹1000** to eligible **women heads of families**.

The **Pudhumai Penn Scheme**, introduced in **2022**, provides a monthly financial assistance of **₹1000** to **girl students** pursuing higher education in government colleges.

The **Chief Minister's Breakfast Scheme**, launched in **2022**, provides **free breakfast** to government school students from **Class 1 to 5**.

The **Illam Thedi Kalvi** scheme, launched in **2021**, aims to bridge **learning gaps** caused by the **COVID-19 pandemic** through volunteer-led remedial education at home.

The **Naan Mudhalvan scheme** focuses on providing **skill training** and placement opportunities for the **youth** of Tamil Nadu.
